

Tom Brokaw's "Greatest Generation" actually lives in Winslow Gardens and Linn Health Care Center. In all of our conversations with residents, our favorite talks center around their personal recollections of the past. Placing them in the context of the textbook history we know, from the life stories they share, is fascinating. Once you've listened to a World War II fighter pilot, a 'Rosie the Riveter' machinist, an Army nurse, a jazz musician, a ballroom dance instructor - tell you the way it really was - you never forget.

There are the poignant, sometimes painful, memories of emigrating -- stories of the old country and the transition to life in America. We are told of one parent going ahead to earn enough money and find a place to live while the other parent kept the

home intact; sometimes living apart for years. A few who left home as young adults, said goodbye to parents they never saw again. Stories of learning the new language and new ways, yet holding on to a sense of cultural identity -- most are funny, some tinged with bitterness.

There were hard times we can't even imagine -- no indoor plumbing, central heat, or electric light, influenza that decimated families; siblings that did not survive the first year of life, and children of their own that they have outlived; starting work at 15 because the family could not afford to keep them in high school; and years of night school.

Country living meant on a farm, not a charming week-end getaway. Think milking, churning, bringing in hay, picking, canning, and pickling -- after growing or raising almost everything they ate, bluing and starching laundry, turning collars, mending ... the list of chores goes on.


A recurring theme runs through these recollections -- the thirst for schooling, and, working hard to 'get ahead'.

Shifting to the present tense, life goes on, and the cultural stereotypes of 'old lady' and 'old man' are at serious risk here. Our residents volunteer to work in the Country Store, plan worship services, make crafts for the Bazaar, visit shut-ins, and pitch in to help each other and the staff. When able, they volunteer in the community. Getting out and about to see new places, try a different cuisine, have fun together -- definite priorities.

We think of this work as a privilege -- we are privileged to serve and enrich the lives of 206 elders who have experienced and given so much. Lifetimes of lessons about faith, resilience, and sharing are right before us; we just have to listen and learn.

*United Methodist Elder Care is on course and moving ahead. Our update highlights progress made and reports challenges remaining:*

#### OCTOBER 2002

##### **Winslow Gardens and Linn Health Care Center - Our New Names**

The naming and re-dedication of Winslow Gardens and Linn Health Care Center renews our commitment to serve all who need us without regard to gender, ethnicity, race, or religious beliefs. Our new names were chosen as long overdue expressions of our deeply felt gratitude for the Winslow and Linn families' contributions to this ministry.

#### JUNE 2003

##### **ElderCare Consultants, LLC Is Formed**

In response to requests for consultancy services, the Trustees formed a new subsidiary, Elder Care Consultants, LLC. Housing and assisted living providers face the same dilemma that we addressed a decade ago. As older residents age, they need help with meals, shopping, personal care, housekeeping and laundry, at a minimum. Providing a flexible and tailored menu of services delays or may prevent nursing home placement. This group will work with housing and assisted living providers planning to develop and operate just such supportive service programs. Clients will benefit from the years of experience we've had creating a responsive, resident-centered, elder care community.

#### NOVEMBER 2003

##### **Home Sweet Supportive Home**

The expansion of our affordable assisted living program in Winslow Gardens readied us to house and care for twice as many frail elders-in-need. A 1.4 million Assisted Living Conversion Program grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development funded the renovation and conversion of 25 additional apartments to assisted living units. Now we offer a total of 50 affordable assisted living apartments to low-income elders in the community. Doubling our capacity put a small and temporary dent in our waiting list; but, new inquiries and applications are flowing in. The need for this supportive housing alternative to Medicaid funded nursing home residence appears to be growing.

#### DECEMBER 2003 INSURING QUALITY

The Trustees are in the planning phase of a \$1.5 million comprehensive campaign to upgrade essential fire, life safety, communication, and monitoring systems and update residents' dining and bathing areas, as well as, fund and endow our chaplaincy and affordable assisted living programs.

#### GROWING THE MISSION

Thirty-three years of experience allow us to confidently state that the oldest of the aged thrive on a neighborly campus that predicts and responds to ever-increasing needs; be those medical, social, emotional, practical, financial, spiritual ... any combination of individualized requirements for a comfortable, fulfilling life. There will come a time in the future when we will be invited to adapt and transplant the United Methodist Elder Care model to new sites in progressive communities. We are both willing and able.


